NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 9th December, 2005

G.S.R. 412. —In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Department of Posts (Assistant Accounts Officer) Recruitment Rules, 1991, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Assistant Accounts Officer in the Department of Posts, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Department of Posts, (Assistant Accounts Officer) Recruitment Rules, 2005.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of posts, their classification and scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of Recruitment, age limit, educational and other qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, educational and other qualifications and other matters related thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

4. Sphere of duty.—Members of the service shall constitute a circle cadre and shall not be liable for transfer out of circle.

5. Disqualification.—No persons,—

(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Savings.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen, and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
