Subject : Submissions of P&TAFOA regarding few important agenda points requiring urgent attention -  
reg

Respected Sir,

Kindly refer to our earlier letter no. CHQ/P&TAFOA/2022-23/004 dated 7<sup>th</sup> August 2022 wherein it was requested for an urgent formal meeting to discuss some important cadre issues that involve policy decisions affecting the members of the Association and require immediate attention.

2. Since no formal meeting could take place, few important agenda points are elaborated herewith for your kind perusal and consideration:

***Item No. 1 : Consideration of transfer requests of AAOs posted outside their home circles, against the vacancies resulting in the respective circles of choice due to promotions of AAOs to AOs.***

Sir, several AAOs are posted in Circles outside their Home Circles since the declaration of the results of LDCE-2018 and several AAOs were also transferred out from their Home Circles subsequently due to administrative exigencies. However, regular promotions from AAO to AO in May-2022 has created vacancies in AAO posts in almost all Circles. Several AAOs have already submitted requests for transfer to their Home Circles against the vacant posts in their Home Circles/ Circles of Choice.

Further, the LDCE-2022 examinations are over and the results are expected to be released soon, save any administrative exigencies.

In view of the above points, it is requested to consider the requests of those AAOs who have submitted requests for transfer to their Home Circles/ Circles of choice, before the LDCE-2022 results/ postings are announced so that AAOs of 2018-batch, being seniors, are accommodated to their home circles in terms of amendment no. 3(xi) of the DoP PA Wing OM No. 2-13/2010-PACE/Trf.Policy/3481-3551 dated 16.12.2014. Such consideration for transfers may be made on a first-out-first-in basis before declaration of the results of LDCE-2022.

It has also come to the notice that several Circles/ Offices are not forwarding the transfer requests of the officers to the concerned authority, which is causing grievances and fear among the officers who desire transfer to their stations of choice. The requests of such officers may also be considered while making any transfers.

***Item No. 2 : Timely grant of NFU for AAOs who will be completing 4 years of service in Grade Pay of Rs.4800/- (PB2/Level 8) in IP&TAFS Group B in terms of Ministry of Finance OM No. 25-2/2017-IC/E.III(A) dated 18.06.2018.***

Sir, in continuation of the Resolution No. 7 of the Association Letter No. CHQ/P&TAFOA/2022-23/003 dated 05.08.2022, it is once again reiterated that AAOs of LDCE-2018 batch will be completing 4 years of service in Grade Pay of Rs.4800/- (PB2/Level 8) in IP&TAFS Group B service and as per MoF OM No. 25-2/2017-IC/E.III(A) dated 18.06.2018, they will be eligible for NFU in the Level 9 (Rs. 5400/- PB2) of the 7<sup>th</sup> CPC Pay Matrix. This upgradation assumes significance because several attendant benefits relating to tour/ travel entitlements, LTC, etc are closely linked to this upgradation. Any delay in timely grant of the NFU will result in denial of the rightful attendant benefits to the officers.

Therefore, the Association requests your good self to instruct the concerned authorities to issue necessary instructions for grant of NFU in the Grade Pay of Rs. 5400 (PB2) Level 9 of the 7<sup>th</sup> CPC Pay Matrix to those AAOs who will be completing 4 years of service in Grade Pay of Rs.4800/- (PB2/Level 8) in IP&TAFS Group B service in advance, i.e. before October 2022.

***Item No. 3 : Inordinate delay in grant of promotions in JTS for the vacancy year 2022.***

Sir, it has already been pointed out in the Resolution No. 7 of the Association Letter No. CHQ/P&TAFOA/2022-23/003 dated 05.08.2022, and it is once again submitted for your kind information that the JTS promotions for the vacancy year 2022 has again been delayed. The promotions which were due from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022 has not happened till date. Several officers who are due for promotions have retired/ are due to retire without getting their rightful promotions.

Therefore, the Association requests your good self to take up the matter with the concerned authorities so that the JTS promotions can be expedited.

3. The Association once again requests your good self for a formal meeting with the office bearers/ representatives of the Association at your convenience to discuss issues concerning members of the Association and for the betterment of the cadre and the service.
