**MINUTES OF THE BIENNIAL MEETING OF THE P&T ACCOUNTS AND FINANCE OFFICERS
ASSOCIATION NORTH EAST CIRCLE, SHILLONG AND DIMAPUR**

Date: 10.01.2026

Venue: Conference Hall, Postal Circle Office Shillong (including Google Meet)

Chair: Chairperson of the Circle Meeting (Sri SriRam Ojha, Sr. AO)

Nature of Meeting: Biennial Meeting for formation of new Executive Committee and discussion of ongoing issues

1. Opening of the Meeting

The biennial meeting of the Union was convened to deliberate on the formation of a new Executive Committee and to discuss various ongoing and emerging issues concerning members. The meeting commenced with the opening remarks by the Chairperson.

The Chairperson emphasized the importance of the Union and highlighted the significant work undertaken by the Union in the past for the welfare of its members.

2. Introduction of New Members

The Chairperson requested the newly inducted members to introduce themselves. Accordingly, all the new members of the **2024 AAO batch** formally introduced themselves to the house.

3. Proposal regarding Strength of Executive Committee

The Chairperson drew attention to the issue of Executive Committee strength being adversely affected due to retirement or transfer of an executive member. He proposed that, as per the provisions of the Union's Constitution, the Union shall have the authority to include a suitable member to replace an outgoing executive member by conducting an Executive Body Meeting. The proposal was noted and agreed upon in principle.

4. Address by the Convener

The Chairperson invited the Convener to address the gathering. The Convener welcomed all members and outlined the agenda for the formation of the new Executive Committee. Prior to the formation of the committee, the convener invited members to share their views and concerns on issues affecting the cadre and the Union.

5. Address by the Finance Secretary

The Finance Secretary was then invited to address the gathering. He emphasized the importance of having a strong and active union, discussed various aspects of union functioning, and welcomed the new members. He also presented the **Finance Report** before the members, which was noted by the house.

6. General Discussion and Issues Raised

The Chairperson opened the floor for detailed discussion. The following members shared their views and raised issues:

- **Sri G. Valte (Member):** Thanked the Union and assured full support. He informed that a certain amount of membership fee is pending remittance from the CCA office and requested the new Finance Secretary to take necessary action.
- **Sri Yogendra Kumar Sahu (Member):** Highlighted the limited promotion opportunities for newly joined AAOs and requested exploration of eligibility for appearing in other departments' Group 'A' departmental examinations.
- **Sri Shanu Verma (Member):** Sought updates on discussions regarding considering AAO as a feeding cadre to enable MACP benefits for newly joined AAOs of the 2024 batch.

- **Sri Dharamdas Oraon (Member):** Assured collective efforts for the betterment of the Union.
- **Sri Ramjas Yadav (Member):** Emphasized the importance of career progression and suggested considering upgradation of the pay scale of the AAO cadre in the next Pay Commission.
- **Smt. Deepsikha Das (Member):** Spoke on the essence of a union and assured her active involvement in union activities.
- **Ms. V. Poornima (Member):** Emphasized the importance of the Union and suggested that officers posted in the North Eastern Circle should be exempted from Income Tax, similar to Scheduled Tribe exemptions.
- **Smt. Neelam Modak (Member):** Highlighted the transfer policy as a common concern and sought guidance from senior officers regarding section work.
- **Smt. Mousami Ghosh (Member)** (joined via Google Meet from NE-II, Dimapur): Expressed happiness over active participation by new members. She emphasized strengthening the cadre and raised issues related to transfer policy, suggesting relaxation for officers posted in NE Circle. She also highlighted that NE-II officers are not receiving 20% HRA.
- **Sri Kishor Hazarika (Member)** (joined via Google Meet from NE-II, Dimapur): Supported the concerns regarding HRA and transfer policy for NE-II.
- **Sri Kundal Das (Member)** (joined via Google Meet): Congratulated the Union for conducting the meeting.
- **Sri Saikat Dutta (Member):** Raised the issue of **Special Compensatory (Remote Locality) Allowance** not being granted in CCA-I, which was discussed by the Chair.

All the issues raised by members were extensively discussed and deliberated upon by the Chairperson.

9. Replacement of Outgoing Executive Members


