Subject:- Promotion of Accounts officers to higher functional grade of Sr. Accounts officer of IP&T AFS Gr. 'B' in the pay band-3 of Rs. 15600-39100+ Grade Pay of Rs. 5400/- on purely temporary and officiating basis.

Sir,


I am directed to refer to your office letter No. GJT/ CCA/OFFPG PRO/CAO/2012 dated 01.08.2012 on the subject cited above. In this context, it is intimated that as per Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure's OM No. F-6 (S21-IC/91 dated 22-09-1992, 80% of the sanctioned strength of Audit/Accounts Officers were ordered to be placed in the promotional scale (2200-75-2800-EB-100-400) w.e.f. 01-04-1987. Since Sr. Accounts Officer is an all India cadre, the ratio of 80:20 is to be maintained centrally by the Head Quarter and not by the circle. Accordingly regular promotion orders to the cadre of Sr. AO are being issued by this Directorate only. Promotion to the cadre of Sr. Accounts Officer is on functional basis, based on the vacancies arising against the 80% of the total number of sanctioned posts of Accounts Officers of both the departments i.e. DoP/DoT and the ratio of 80:20 is to be maintained by the Hqrs. Centrally. All India Gradation List of AO/Sr.AO is maintained centrally by O/o DDG (PAF). Promotion from AO to Sr. AO is not like Financial upgradation which can be considered on completion of required qualifying service and therefore, local officiating promotion to the cadre of Sr. AO cannot be done at Circle level, without knowing all India vacancy position.

A case of similar nature officiating promotion in the cadre of SAO granted by CCA, Karnataka has already been referred to Member (F) which is pending for a decision.

Subject: - Promotion of Accounts officers of IP&T AFS Gr. 'B' working under PAOs to higher functional grade of Sr. Accounts officer on purely temporary and officiating basis.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your office letter No. Admn.I/ B/GO(2)/II/2325 dated 19.07.2012 on the subject cited above. In this context, it is intimated that as per Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure's OM No. F-6 (82)-IC/91 dated 22-09-1992, 80% of the sanctioned strength of Audit/Accounts Officers were ordered to be placed in the promotional scale (2200-75-2800-EB-100-400) w.e.f. 01-04-1987. Since Sr. Accounts Officer is an all India cadre, the ratio of 80:20 is to be maintained centrally by the Head Quarter and not by the circle. Accordingly regular promotion orders to the cadre of Sr. AO are being issued by this Directorate only. Promotion to the cadre of Sr. Accounts Officer is on functional basis, based on the vacancies arising against the 80% of the total number of sanctioned posts of Accounts Officers of both the departments i.e. DoP/DoT and the ratio of 80:20 is to be maintained by the Hqrs. Centrally. Promotion from AO to Sr. AO is not like **Financial upgradation** which can be considered on completion of required qualifying service. Therefore, the request of the officers for local officiating promotion on adhoc basis from AO to Sr.AO cadre can not be considered and this can not be delegated to Heads of the PAO.
